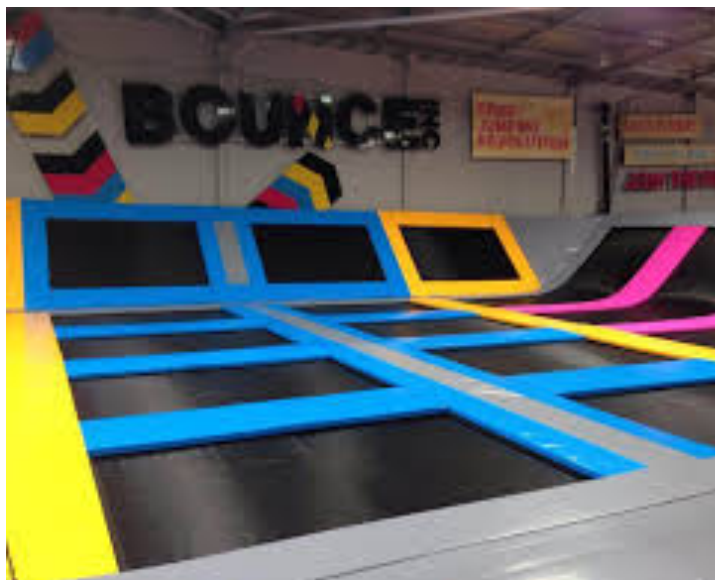


Marymount College
