On the bus	Students are required to:
	Use seats when available
	<ul> <li>Keep hands and feet to themselves</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Do not throw any items on the bus</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Do not eat or drink on the bus</li> </ul>
	Remove any litter
	Behave in a calm, non-aggressive manner
	Speak politely
	Keep body and objects inside the bus windows
Exiting the bus	Students are required to:
	Get off the bus in an orderly fashion
	Never cross the road in front of the bus
<b>Consequences:</b> Possible suspension from use of buses. Other consequences as outlined in the College Student Behaviour Support Plan.
