Applications to be considered for a Griffith University early offer close **Monday 17 October**. Year 12 students who meet their eligibility criteria can lock in an offer for a Griffith degree sooner. All you need to do is submit your application to QTAC by **Monday 17 October**. Students will need to follow these three simple steps to be considered for an early offer:

- Submit a QTAC application by **Monday 17 October**, listing one of the available degrees or double degrees as your first preference.
- Griffith will send students an invitation via email within a couple of days of you submitting your application. Students will also be able to see your invitation by logging into your QTAC application and clicking on 'Outstanding Documents'.
- Students will need to upload all documentation to your QTAC application by **Monday 31 October**.

Undergraduate Diplomas: Might not get the ATAR you need for your desired degree? Griffith Uni are introducing eight undergraduate diplomas for 2023 entry. The diplomas give students a supported start to university studies to help them transition to their chosen Bachelor degree. For example, if a student just misses out on the ATAR cut-off for a range of Bachelor degrees, they can first complete one of the matching Undergraduate Diplomas to gain entry. Once students have successfully completed the Diploma, they'll be offered guaranteed entry into the second year of the corresponding Bachelor degree. Other benefits for Diploma students include spending their first year alongside peers in the Bachelor degree and finishing in the same amount of time, at no extra cost.
