SCHOOL BUS CODE OF CONDUCT

It is a basic student right to be safe, respected and to be treated fairly when on the bus. This is also a basic right for the bus driver and anyone from the public who happens to be on the bus. Marymount College students are expected to comply with the following Code of Conduct which aligns with all College Behaviour Management policies.

NB: This code applies for all bus travel related to Marymount College.

Students' Responsibilities	Students are required to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Act safely and responsibly • Pay the fare • Follow all driver instructions • Respect self and others • Respect own property and property of others • Communicate respectfully with others
Prior to boarding the bus	Students are required to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Behave sensibly in the waiting area • Follow teacher instructions • Line up patiently and appropriately on arrival of the bus
On the bus	Students are required to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use seats when available • Keep hands and feet to themselves • Do not throw any items on the bus • Do not eat or drink on the bus • Remove any litter • Behave in a calm, non-aggressive manner • Speak politely • Keep body and objects inside the bus windows
Exiting the bus	Students are required to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Get off the bus in an orderly fashion • Never cross the road in front of the bus
Consequences: Possible suspension from use of buses. Other consequences as outlined in the College Student Behaviour Support Plan.
