<u>Undergraduate Diplomas:</u> Might not get the ATAR you need for your desired degree? Griffith Uni are introducing eight undergraduate diplomas for 2023 entry. The diplomas give students a supported start to university studies to help them transition to their chosen Bachelor degree. For example, if a student just misses out on the ATAR cut-off for a range of Bachelor degrees, they can first complete one of the matching Undergraduate Diplomas to gain entry. YOUNG ENDEAVOUR YOUTH SCHEME - SAIL TRAINING 2023 - YEAR 12

Applications are now open for youth development voyages. The *Young Endeavour* is a specially designed and purpose-built boat for sail training. Together, 24 youth from across Australia make up the youth crew and learn how to keep watch on deck, handle lines, take the helm, navigate using the ship's electronic charts, assist the chef in the gally and climb the 30 metre mast to set and furl sails. No sailing experience is required, only a willingness to give everything a try. Voyages last for 11 days. STUDENTS INTERESTED IN TERTIARY EDUCATION IN THE US

The Southport School is once again hosting the PSAT/NMSQT as scheduled by U.S. College Board on **Saturday 15 October 2022 @ 8:00am.** The U.S. College pathway is a very real and exciting opportunity, with several thousand colleges offering multitudes of majors with accompanying scholarships of varying value. The first stage of deciding if U.S. tertiary studies are a good fit for you and your future, is to sit the upcoming PSAT at TSS (internationally accredited testing centre with College Board USA).

<u>What is the PSAT</u>? The PSAT is a standardised test directed at both Year 10 and Year 11 students who have aspirations of completing Year 12 before heading on to college in the USA via an academic pathway and/or athletic scholarship. The October PSAT (termed the PSAT/NMSQT) is used to **determine eligibility and qualification for the National Merit Scholarship Program.** Competition is tough, however students with top PSAT/NMSQT scores can be awarded significant scholarships. TSS offers the following tests on recommended timeline below:

YEAR 10: First PSATYEAR 11: Second PSAT

YEAR 12: SAT (usually taken twice in Year 12)

PSAT administrations usually fill to capacity therefore we encourage you to <u>register as soon as possible</u> to ensure your place in the testing cohort. Please contact the Careers Centre here at the College to be given further information and details on how to register.

GAP YEAR IN AGRICULTURE
